- Alto Sax:** Certified - C to D, and G to H; El Abrazo - TBA
Tenor Sax: Certified - C to D, and G to H; El Abrazo - TBA
Bari Sax: Certified - C to D, and G to H; El Abrazo - TBA
Trumpet: Certified - pick-up to C to D, and G to H, El Abrazo - TBA
Trombone: Certified - B to C, and H to end, El Abrazo - TBA
Piano: Certified - pickups to B to C, and comp D to E, if you can,
El Abrazo - TBA
Bass: Certified - play A to B, as written, and walk D to E, if you can,
El Abrazo - TBA
Guitar: Certified - pickups to B to C, and comp D to E, if you can,

Drums: Certified - Beginning to C, El Abrazo - TBA
