SCHOOL-SPONSORED TRIP REQUIREMENTS AND EXPECTATIONS

Prior to the Trip

- *Behavior:* School-sponsored trips are a privilege that must be earned through the consistent display of responsibility, civility, and integrity. - Additional rules and expectations may be communicated by the trip's facilitator(s). Students and parents/guardians must be aware of these communications.

During the Trip

- All district and school rules apply while on the trip. Students who violate district or school rules while on the trip may face early cancellation of the current trip (without financial reimbursement) and disciplinary consequences upon returning to school.
